Week of January 28, 2018

Sunday January 28

At 2:33 a.m. officers were dispatched to State Highway 18 and Lakeview Drive, Sadsbury Township, for the report of debris blocking the roadway.

Monday January 29

At 10:49 p.m. officers were dispatched to a Lakeside Drive residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a domestic argument. It was determined that the male had departed the residence prior to police arrival and that a verbal argument prompted the call for police assistance.

Tuesday January 30

At 1:15 p.m. officers were dispatched to a Choctaw Circle residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of theft. The caller reported a stolen dog by an ex-boyfriend. Investigation revealed that both parties had a vested monetary interest in the animal and were referred to civil court.

Wednesday January 31

At 10:00 a.m. officers were dispatched to a Water Street residence, Conneaut Lake Borough, to execute a search warrant for methamphetamine manufacture. Officers conducted an ongoing investigation resulting in evidence indicating the manufacturing of methamphetamine and in conjunction with the Attorney General's Office and PA State Police executed the warrant. Two persons were taken into custody, arraigned before the district judge and incarcerated.

At 4:15 p.m. officers were dispatched to US Highway 6 near State Highway 618, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a reckless driver. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.

Thursday February 01

At 5:40 p.m. officers were dispatched to Leach Road residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of behavioral disorder. It was reported that a 12 year old male ran into the woods and was unable to be located. After a search of the area by officers, the male returned to the residence.

At 7:36 p.m. officers were dispatched to a South 3rd Street residence, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of a domestic argument. The investigation is continuing.

At 3:08 a.m. officers located a suspicious vehicle at a Water Street church parking lot, Conneaut Lake Borough. All was determined to be okay.

At 8:41 p.m. officers were dispatched to an Old State Road residence, Sadsbury Twp., for a suspicious vehicle. It was reported that a van load of males repeatedly drove past the residence and on one occasion requested to speak with a female. After an extensive search, officers were unable to locate the vehicle.
