### **Weekly Police Blotter**

#### **Week of February 18, 2018**

##### **Sunday February 18**

At 8:53 a.m. officers were dispatched to a Hickory Drive residence, Sadsbury Township, for the request of a check the welfare. Contact was made and all was determined to be okay.

At 8:30 p.m. officers were dispatched to a State Street residence, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of criminal mischief. It was determined that a neighbor fell into the caller's vehicle causing minor damage. Since the act was not deliberate, the caller was referred to civil court.

At 10:19 a.m. officers were dispatched to a Hickory Drive residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of fraud. It was determined that unknown person(s) obtained personal information from the 71 year old Conneaut Lake female and opened a financial account in Texas.
