Monday May 14

At 3:48 p.m. officers were dispatched to the 11000 block of Conneaut Lake Road, Sadsbury Twp., for a request to speak with an officer. The caller was referred to a civil attorney after claiming that he drove through smoke from a burn barrel and it gave him a headache.

Tuesday May 15

At 6:55 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 900 block of State Street, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of a downed wire blocking the roadway.

At 12:00 p.m. officers were dispatched to State Highway 285 and Free Road, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a motor vehicle crash. The operators simply opted to exchange information due to minor damage to the vehicles.

At 12:00 p.m. officers participated in the annual county Police Memorial Service at the county courthouse.

At 2:21 p.m. officers were dispatched to State Highway 18 near Midway Drive, Sadsbury Twp., for a traffic complaint. It was reported that an elderly male operating a black Chevrolet Cobalt nearly caused several crashes. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.

Thursday May 17

At 9:30 a.m. officers executed an arrest warrant for a male that reported to the Vernon Police Dept. to speak with an officer. The male was arraigned on felony theft and bad check charges and incarcerated.

At 10:30 a.m. officers were dispatched to Lakeside Drive and Oak Street, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a suspicious vehicle. The caller reported two children left alone in a maroon vehicle. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.

Two males in a known vehicle caused a disturbance at the business and the vehicle was located on W. Vernon Road. A 35 year old Conneaut Lake male was arrested for outstanding warrants out of Venango County and incarcerated.

At 9:21 p.m. officers were dispatched to Allen Road and Beagle Road near the township lines of Sadsbury and Summit Twps., for the report of an ATV crash with injuries. Officers determined the crash to be in Summit Twp. and assisted PA State Police at the scene.

It was learned that a Beaver County male threatened to shoot several people and was enroute to the campground. During the investigation, officers contacted Beaver County law enforcement and learned that the male was currently being detained by them for an ongoing domestic dispute.
