Sunday June 10

At 10:55 a.m. officers were dispatched to a Penn Lake Village residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a domestic argument. A male and female were having a verbal argument throughout the morning. One party voluntarily left the property for the day.

Monday June 11

At 1:00 a.m. officers located a male pedestrian walking on US Highway 6, Sadsbury Twp., after his vehicle became disabled. An officer provided a courtesy ride to his residence.
