

## **Conneaut Lake Regional Police**

### **Weekly Police Blotter**

#### **Week of October 07, 2018**

##### **Sunday October 07**

At 10:46 p.m. officers were dispatched to Conneaut Lake Road, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a reckless driver to assist Vernon Twp. police. The vehicle was eventually located on State Highway 18 by Pa State Police Troopers.
