### **Weekly Police Blotter**

#### **Week of November 04, 2018**

##### **Sunday November 04**

At 6:50 p.m. officers located a pile of leaves burning in the street in the 10000 block of Utley Avenue, Sadsbury Twp. Officers put the fire out.

At 8:26 p.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 9500 block of US Highway 322, Sadsbury Twp., to assist Farrell City PD regarding possible stolen firearms.

##### **Monday November 05**

At 8:06 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 10000 block of State Highway 285, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a traffic violation. It was reported that a motorist failed to stop for red flashing school bus lights at a bus stop. After review of bus video it was determined by the busing company that no violation occurred.

At 8:45 a.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 11000 block of Aldina Drive, Sadsbury Twp., for a security check. A neighbor reported the garage door left open. Officers checked the residence and all was determined to be okay and the garage was secured by officers.

##### **Tuesday November 06**

At 6:43 p.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 10000 block of School Road, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a missing juvenile. The father reported his 15 year old son did not return to the residence after school. Officers eventually located the juvenile with the caller's ex-wife.

##### **Wednesday November 07**

At 2:16 a.m. officers were dispatched to the Sheetz Convenience Store on Water Street, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of a suspicious vehicle. A female was reportedly passed out in the vehicle. Officers made contact with a 29 year old Meadville female that had recently moved to the area and was tired after driving from Iowa Park, Texas.

At 6:17 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 12000 block of Conneaut Lake Road, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a motor vehicle crash. It was learned that Kaylin Evans, 34, Meadville, was following a vehicle operated by David Nisely, 47, Cochran, when her vehicle rear-ended the Nisely vehicle. There were no reported injuries but at least one of the vehicles required towing.

At 8:20 a.m. officers were dispatched to a Highland Avenue residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a possible missing person. The friend of a 29 year old Conneaut Lake male reported his friend had not been seen or heard from for 48 hours and he was concerned for his welfare. Officers placed a locate to nearby police departments to attempt to locate the male.

At 11:26 a.m. officers were dispatched to the 8500 block of State Highway 285, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of wires hanging in the roadway. Responding officers located the wires and contacted Windstream to respond to take care of the issue.

At 12:05 p.m. officers were dispatched to the 8500 block of State Highway 285, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a commercial vehicle striking a low hanging wire which damaged the utility pole causing a power outage. Penelec responded and restored the power immediately.

#### **Thursday November 08**

At 8:57 a.m. officers were dispatched to State Highway 285 from Alter Road to the N. Shenango Twp. line, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of numerous pop cans all over the highway. It was learned that 2 elderly Ohio males were transporting a trailer load of cans for recycling when the tarp blew off causing numerous cans to fly out. The grandparents of a 29 year old Conneaut Lake male filed an endangered missing person report after the grandson had not been in contact for several days. At around 2:21 p.m. the male was located at the Home Depot in Meadville with Vernon Twp. and Conneaut Lake officers responding. Officers transported the male to a local hospital for assistance.

At 2:00 p.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 10000 block of State Highway 285, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a child custody dispute.

At 8:22 p.m. officers were dispatched to a Comstock Street residence, Sadsbury Twp., to assist Vernon Twp. Police with locating an owner of an abandoned vehicle.

#### **Friday November 09**

At 12:53 a.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 9000 block of US Highway 6, Sadsbury Twp., for a possible death investigation. It was determined that the person died of natural causes.

At 2:46 p.m. officers were dispatched to Conneaut Lake Road, Sadsbury Twp., to assist Vernon Twp. Police in locating a black sedan that fled Walmart after a retail theft. Officers were unable to locate the vehicle.

At 3:41 p.m. officers were dispatched to Brown Street, Sadsbury Twp., regarding a parking and property dispute. The parties were referred to civil attorneys.
