Monday November 26

At 6:07 p.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 11000 block of Allen Road, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of theft. The resident reported his daughter's cellular phone being stolen from Conneaut Lake Area Middle School. The caller was referred to the School Resource Officer for the school district.

At 9:05 p.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 10000 block of Utley Avenue, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a child custody dispute. The parties were referred to domestic relations regarding the custody order.
