### **Weekly Police Blotter**

#### **Week of December 02, 2018**

##### **Sunday December 02**

At 3:00 p.m. officers were dispatched to Sheetz Water Street, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of a hit and run. A Jamestown, PA female reported her truck being struck while in the parking lot. After review of store video no vehicles struck the truck.

At 11:02 p.m. officers were dispatched to the 10000 block of Cherokee Trail, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of 911 call hang ups. No one was contacted at the residence and all appeared to be okay.
