Sunday December 09

It was learned that the female spouse assaulted and damaged the residence. The female departed the residence prior to police arrival and charges are pending.

A 26 year old Conneaut Lake male departed the residence prior to police arrival after assaulting his 31 year old female spouse and a 28 year old Conneaut Lake male also in the residence. Charges are pending.

Saturday December 15

Upon arrival it was determined that Linda Stewart, 56, Greenville, attempted to turn onto the street and entered a roadside ditch. The vehicle was pulled from the ditch by neighbors and the property owner.

At 8:59 p.m. officers were dispatched to an apartment building in the 12000 block of Lakeside Drive, Sadsbury Twp., for a request for officer. Upon arrival the female caller reported that after a child custody exchange she felt a male placed narcotics in her vehicle to get her in trouble. Officers searched her vehicle and no narcotics were located.

Miscellaneous. Officers responded to assist fire, EMS, and citizens on 8 occasions and answered 3 alarm calls. Patrol officers conducted 7 traffic stops resulting in 5 traffic citations being issued.
