Sunday February 03

At 12:53 a.m. officers located two suspicious vehicles at a North Second Street, Conneaut Lake Borough parking area. Officers learned the male and female were meeting each other at the location. Both were advised by officers of the borough ordinance prohibiting parking after 10pm.

At 2:22 a.m. officers located four juvenile males located at a Water Street business, Conneaut Lake Borough. Officers made contact with the juveniles and advised them of the borough curfew ordinance at 11p.m.

Monday February 04

At 6:29 p.m. officers were dispatched to the intersection of State Highway 618 and McClure St, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a male walking around residences. Officers patrolled the area in attempt to locate the male.
