### **Weekly Police Blotter**

#### **Week of March 10 , 2019**

##### **Sunday March 10**

At 1:05 a.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 1500 block of State Highway 285, N. Shenango Twp., for the report of a 911 call check. Officers were unable to locate anything.

At 4:21 a.m. officers were dispatched to Sheetz on Water Street, Conneaut Lake Borough, for a citizens assist request. An elderly male was unable to walk to a nearby apartment complex due to weather. Officers provided a courtesy ride to the male.

At 5:30 a.m. officers were dispatched to a Water Street residence, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of a 911 call check. All appeared to be okay.

At 1:34 p.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 12000 block of Conneaut Lake Road, Sadsbury Twp., for a behavioral disorder. The caller was transported by ambulance for evaluation.

##### **Monday March 11**

##### **Tuesday March 12**

The original report was that a father assaulted a daughter and locked her in the basement. Officers determined that in fact the adult daughter and her father had an argument and she retreated to the basement where she lives and that no assault occurred. The parties were referred to civil attorneys as the argument was over the daughter not working or taking care of her children.

It was learned that Jackie Moore, 46, Atlantic, PA backed into a vehicle operated by Logan Shannon, 18, Jamestown PA after she decided to change her decision on a turn she intended to make. There were no reported injuries and both vehicles were driven from the scene.

At 5:25 a.m. officers were dispatched to a residence in the 10000 block of McClure Street, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of harassment. It was learned to be a landlord/tenant dispute and the parties were referred to civil attorneys.

Upon contact with the male which was passed out in the vehicle, the 58 year old Meadville male was arrested for public drunkenness and incarcerated.

### **Saturday March 16**

Upon arrival it was learned that a female jumped into the roadway in front of the semi and upon the driver contacting the female she reported being shot in the leg. Officers then transported the female to a medical facility for forced mental health evaluation as this is the same female officers dealt with earlier.
