Week of March 24, 2019

Sunday March 24

At 12:11 a.m. officers observed and contacted a Meadville female and Harmonsburg male in a vehicle at Firemen's Beach, Conneaut Lake Borough, in violation of borough ordinance for park hours. The two were issued verbal warnings for the violation and departed the park area.

At 10:59 a.m. officers were dispatched to a Frances Drive residence, N. Shenango Twp., for the report of a behavioral disorder involving a firearm. The incident was de-escalated by officers and assisting PA State Troopers and the juvenile male was transported for further evaluation.

At 1:13 p.m. officers were dispatched to a Lakeside Drive residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of suspicious activity. Neighbors reported suspicious electrical activity in the area.

At 2:14 p.m. officers were dispatched to a Hickory Street residence, N. Shenango Twp., for the report of a disturbance. It was learned that the resident's adult son appeared at the residence and began an argument and then fled on foot prior to police arrival. The son was located by assisting Pa State Troopers and returned to the residence to obtain personal belongings and returned to Andover OH.

At 7:36 p.m. officers were dispatched to an Utley Avenue residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a behavioral disorder. It was learned that the juvenile male was out of control and assaulting his mother. The male was transported for further evaluation.

Wednesday March 27

The male reported that the female struck him and he requested to leave the property. Officers stood by while he gathered belongings and departed as the male did not display any signs of injury.

Upon arrival officers were met by several neighbors and all could hear a male yelling profanities from a residence. Officers contacted the 24 year old male occupant who was obviously intoxicated about his yelling inside and outside the residence. A citation was filed for disorderly conduct.

Thursday March 28
