Sunday May 19

At 08:02 a.m. officers were dispatched to the area of State Highway 18 and Conneaut Lake Road, Sadsbury Twp. , for the report of a male walking along the roadway yelling at traffic. Officers arrived to find the male under the influence of unknown substance(s). Officer placed the male in custody for public drunkenness and transported the male to local hospital for medical treatment.

At 12:41 p.m. officers were dispatched to an Oakridge Road residence, Sadsbury Twp., for a burning complaint. Officers arrived to find a small fire behind the residence causing smoke in the area. Officers advised the land owner of township burning ordinance(s).

Monday May 20

At 2:47 p.m. officers were dispatched to the Causeway State Highway 285, N. Shenango Twp., for the report of a hit and run. A 2003 gray pickup parked along the south side of the roadway was struck by a motorist traveling east on State Highway 285. The motorist struck the mirror of the parked vehicle and failed to stop. Officers arrived on scene to find a vehicle had left the roadway and traveled into the yard of a residence. Driver was learned to be a 27 year old male from Harmonsburg, Pa who was taken into custody for DUI. Driver refused medical treatment.

At 6:32 a.m. officers were dispatched to the area of an Edgeview Drive residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a suspicious activity. Officers arrived on scene and made contact with the complainant who related they believed they had heard someone breaking into a residence. Officers patrolled the area and were unable to locate any suspicious activity.

At 10:45 a.m. officers were dispatched to a North Second Street address, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of a found black lab. Officers were able to locate the owner of the dog with help of citizens and the dog was returned home safely.

At 3:15 p.m. officers received a report in the 300 block of Water Street, Conneaut Lake Borough, for the report of an assault that occurred on a previous date. Officers are investigating the incident.

At 3:34 p.m. officers were dispatched to an Iroquois Road residence, Sadsbury Twp., for the report of a disturbance. Officers arrived to find a verbal disturbance had occurred between a grandmother of a child at the residence and the mother of the child regarding child custody. Officers were able to get all parties involved to agree on such matter(s) regarding the custody of the child.

Wednesday May 22

Officers learned a 2013 Honda SUV operated by a 70 y.o Andover, Ohio male had stopped for a pedestrian while traveling east. While the Honda was stopped, a 2016 Dodge truck hauling a trailer operated by a 27 y.o Grafton, Ohio male failed to stop and rear ended the Honda. Once the Dodge truck rear ended the Honda, the Honda was pushed into west bound traffic colliding with a third vehicle, a 2007 Ford truck operated by a 61 y.o Saltsburg, Pa male. No injuries occurred as a result of the accident.

Officers learned a vehicle was parked at the residence and when the homeowner approached the vehicle, the vehicle left. Officers patrolled the area in attempt to locate the vehicle.

Miscellaneous. Officers responded to assist fire, EMS, and citizens on 24 occasions and answered 4 alarm calls. Patrol officers conducted 19 traffic stops resulting in 13 traffic citations being issued.
